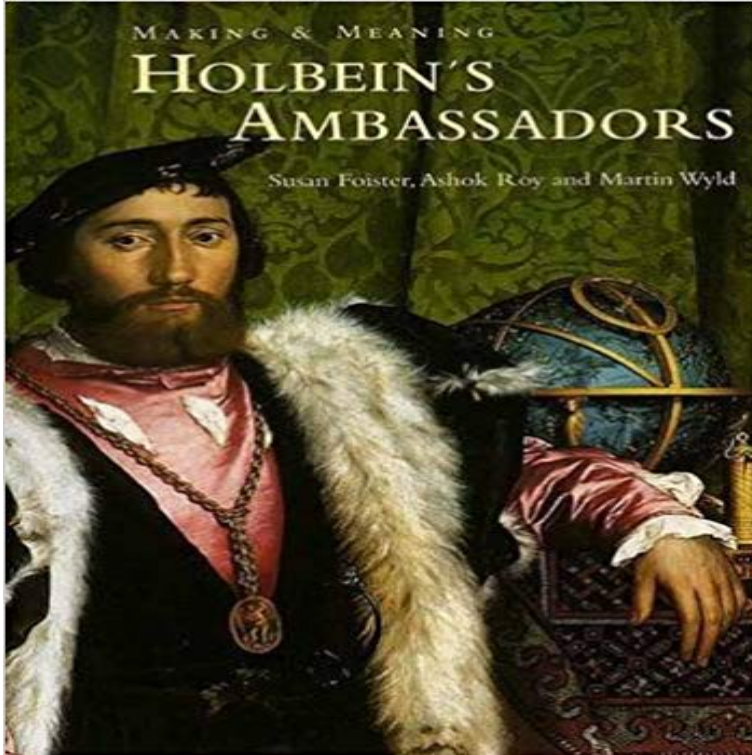


Holbeins Ambassadors: Making and Meaning (National Gallery London Publications)
