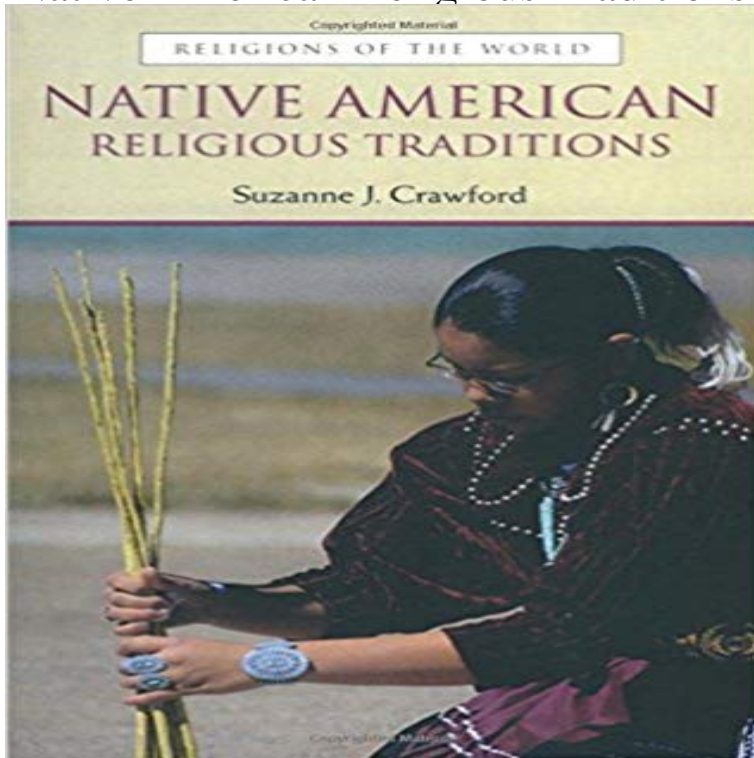


## Native American Religious Traditions
