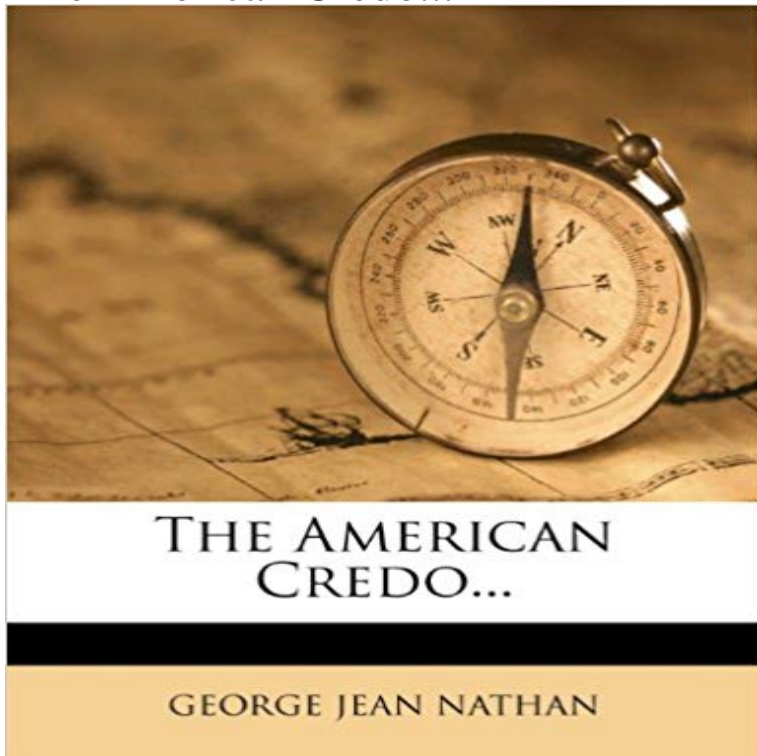


# The American Credo...
